

Fire Of LOVE

Confirmation Rally

POLICIES

REGISTRATION:

- Each group must pre-register at least two weeks prior to the rally by mailing a Group Registration Form with Consent Forms and the total payment for each person (adult and teen) attending the rally.
- Each person must register as part of a group. No individual registrations will be accepted. A group will be defined for this rally as at least one teen and one adult chaperone.
- Due to the nature of this event and the pre-planning required, the \$16.00 fee is nonrefundable and non-transferable.
- Each group must check in at the registration table at the rally site on the day of the rally.
- No additional registrations (individual or group) will be accepted at the door the day of the rally.
- The rally is only open specifically to 8th Graders preparing for Confirmation. No exceptions can be made.
- Young children should not be brought to the FIRE OF LOVE Confirmation Rally.

CHAPERONES:

- Chaperones must be at least 21 years of age and are expected to comply with the youth protection policies of the Diocese of Harrisburg.
- Due to the nature and size of this youth rally, each group must maintain a chaperone to youth ratio of 1:7 throughout the entire day. Chaperones are expected to oversee and assist the youth under their care, especially during free times, Eucharistic Holy Hour and Mass.
- There must be at least one chaperone of each gender if you bring both boys and girls, even if you do not have seven boys or girls coming.

PARTICIPATION

- All participants must be present at all scheduled sessions. No youth is allowed to leave the site grounds unless accompanied by an adult chaperone from their parish/school who accepts full responsibility for that youth.
- Youth are not permitted outside at any time during the FIRE OF LOVE Confirmation Rally.

LUNCH

- Lunch will be provided for the participants. Special dietary needs for certain participants must be handled by the group leader.

FIRST AID

- Refrigeration will be available for any required medication. All medication must be clearly marked with the person's name and dosage instructions. The distribution of this medication is the responsibility of the group leader.

SMOKING

- All FIRE OF LOVE Rally sites are smoke-free environments and no smoking is allowed anywhere inside the facilities. Smoking is allowed in proper areas outside.
- All smokers are expected to dispose of their cigarette butts in a proper receptacle.

DRESS CODE

- All participants are expected to dress appropriately. Clothing must cover all undergarments (including bra straps and boxers) and midriffs. Clothing with offensive language or obscene pictures is not allowed. No low-cut shirts, mini-skirts, or excessively short shorts are allowed. Shoes and shirts must be worn at all times.
- Chaperones are expected to comply with the dress code as well as convey this information to the youth from their group and then enforce it while at the rally.
- Please remember that casual dress is expected, but that it should be appropriate for Eucharistic Adoration and attending Mass (nice jeans and a nice T-shirt are fine).

ITEMS FOR SALE

- Participants may bring spending money with them as there will be several items available for purchase, i.e.: Martin Doman CD's, T-shirts, etc.
- Groups, participants or other individuals are prohibited from distributing any handouts, pamphlets or tracts, tapes without permission from the FIRE OF LOVE coordinators.

PROPERTY

- Each of the FIRE OF LOVE sites are hosts for this rally and all participants are expected to treat the property with respect and to conduct themselves with reverence while in the church, chapel or other places of worship.

WHAT TO BRING / NOT BRING

BRING:

- A heart open to God and His love
- Other optional items:
 - Bible
 - Notebook or prayer journal and pen
 - Rosary
 - Extra spending money for CD's, booklets, T-shirts, etc...

DON'T BRING:

- CD/MP3 Player/iPod
- Cell Phones (OK for group leaders)
- Video Games
- Anything that will distract you or others from God
