

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION OF STUDENTS FOR FIRST PENANCE AND FIRST EUCHARIST

Sacramental preparation catechesis ordinarily must occur in accord with diocesan guidelines before any youth receives the Sacraments of First Penance and First Eucharist.

The following is to be observed in preparing students for the reception of these two sacraments:

1. Catholic schools and parish programs of religious education are each to provide the catechetical instruction to students in preparation for reception of the Sacraments of First Penance and First Eucharist.

a. Those students who attend Catholic schools are not required to attend another instructional program in the parish. The Catholic schools will provide the catechesis for the Sacraments during the regular school day within the Religion curriculum.

b. The parish religious education program will provide the catechesis for the students from the parish who attend public schools.

2. The Sacraments are to be celebrated jointly for all students who attend the Catholic school and the program of religious education.

3. Meetings for parents and Retreat programs and any formational activities for students are the responsibility of each parish.

a. The pastor, the principal, and the coordinator/director of religious education should collaborate on establishing joint sessions for parents and formational activities for the students.

4. In a consolidated school setting, the pastors and the coordinators/directors of religious education from each parish in the consolidation and the school principal should meet to discuss when the Sacraments of First Penance and First Eucharist will be received in each parish. The parishes should schedule the administration of the Sacraments during the same time of year since the teachers in the consolidated school will be preparing all their students simultaneously for the reception of these two Sacraments.
