

REPORTING OF ARRESTS BY SCHOOL VOLUNTEERS

All volunteers are required to notify the Principal if they have been arrested.

The Principal shall notify the Superintendent of Schools of the arrest.

Depending on the nature of the charge, the volunteer may be placed on an administrative leave, while the matter is being reviewed by school administrators.

If the arrest is for a charge that Pennsylvania State law lists as prohibiting a person from employment by a school (see Act 24 2011), the volunteer shall be prohibited from participation in school activities as a volunteer. For all other charges, the school will make a determination of continued volunteer status based on the seriousness of the charge.
