Professor of Theology, Immaculata University

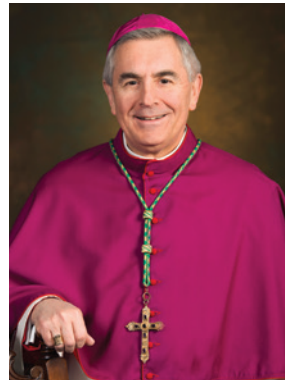

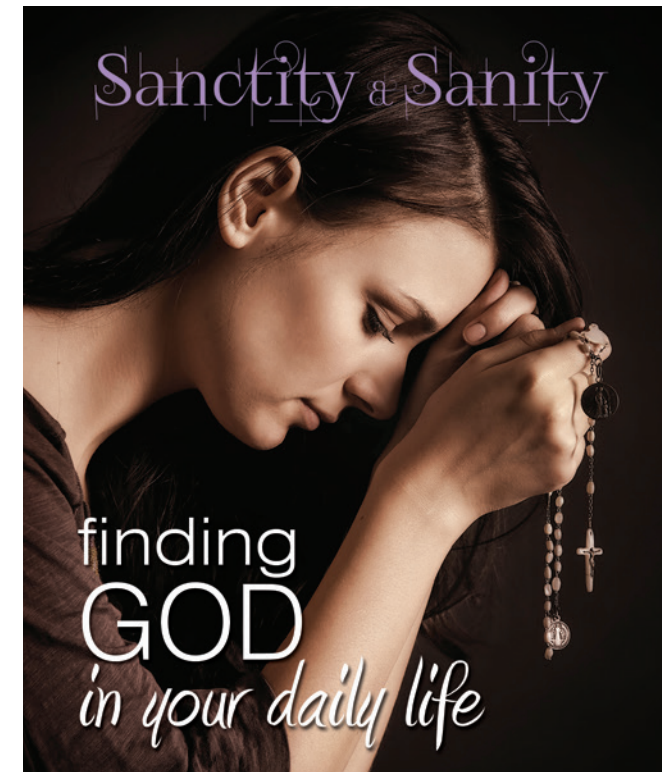
