IMPORTANT INFORMATION

This mandate is not in force until signed by the pastor.

The mandate of the Bishop remains in force for five years or, until decided otherwise by the pastor, priest chaplain, or the Extraordinary Minister. When the Extraordinary Minister leaves the parish or institution the mandate is terminated.

Extraordinary Ministers may function both in a parish and institution, but only with the proper mandate from the Bishop for each location. Nursing homes and hospitals which are ministries of a given parish are included in the mandate for that parish.
